



How to assemble your Gas Stove

While unpacking, make sure that all parts of gas stove are included

 Push the rubber tube is attached to the gas regulator (cylinder) on to the nozzle till the end. The tube should not be twisted, looped or kinked, or subjected to external pressure of any kind.



- Not more than 1.5 meters (4.5ft) length of tube should be used to connect the gas stove. The tube not be extended from one room to another and must not be passed through doors, windows, walls, partition, ceilings or floors.
- After the tube is fixed, the gas stove is ready for use.

How to use Gas Stove

To light your gas stove:

First open the regulator, press the gas control knob and then turn the knob towards the ON position.

Use a gas lighter or alighted match stick to light the gas stove

- The stove may not light at first click, if used after a long gas of time. This is because the gas takes a little time to flow through the pilot tube and ignite the flame
- To ensure faster ignition, press the knob, hold for a second and then turn the knob to ON position.
- Always make sure that the gas is lit when the knob is turned to ON/SIM position. Otherwise the gas will be leaking.
- If the stove does not light, bring the knob to OFF position and repeat until the gas lights.

To simmer the flame:

- Turn the gas control knob to SIM position by turning counter clockwise to reduce or SIM the flame.
- You can cook on different size burners depending on your needs.
 The smaller burner helps you cook food that usually stove doesn't
 take long. The larger burner be used for normal cooking, steaming
 and deep frying. In the 3/4 burners models there is one extra
 larger burner which helps you in faster cooking.

To turn the gas Stove off:

Turn "OFF" the gas regulator. Then, turn the gas control knob the "OFF" position.

Hints:

- When using high flame, ensure that you use large sized vessels to cover the entire flame to avoid wastage of gas.
- When using smaller vessels, reduce the flame intensity to the required optimum.
- After desired temperature is attained while cooking, it is sufficient to keep the flame intensity at a reduced level to maintain the temperature.
- In case, you have any difficulty in assembling the gas stove, please call the nearest Service Center.

Things you should be careful about

- Use the gas stove for cooking only. Do not use dry towels, Cloth etc. over it.
- Always use liquefied petroleum gas (L.P.G.) that comes in a cylinder that can be attached to the gas stove.
 To connect the gas stove to the cylinder, use standard good quality tubing
- only. Do not use vinyl plastic tube, as thin can be dangerous.
 Make sure that the rubber tube does not touch any part of the gas stove or
- Indee sure that the fubble tube does not touch any part of the gas stove of lie underneath it because it is susceptible to burst.
 Always check the rubber tube for any wear and tear to avoid gas leak and
- prevent danger.
 Avoid keeping inflammable near the gas stove.
- When in use, do not touch the pan supports of the gas stove to avoid burns.
- Never apply excessive pressure to the gas control knobs. Do not tamper the knob.
- Clean the burner regularly so that they don't get clogged. Do not use abrasive materials for cleaning.
- After cooking is over, turn both the gas controls knobs and the regulator in 'off' position.
- If you smell gas leaking, Close the gas regulator of the cylinder and then open up all windows and call your gas supply agents immediately. Do not switch on an electric light or light matches/lighters etc.
- The cylinder should not be tilt horizontally when in use. Use always in vertical position.
 Make sure the gas stove should be away from children so that there should
- not be any chance of burnt by flame.
- Keep the gas stove out of reach from children.
- Ensure that no appliances working on electricity or any other fuel are installed within a distance of 1 meter from the LPG installation (Gas stove, Tubing, Regulator and Cylinder).
- Do not drop any heavy objects on the glass surface as it may scratch/shatter the glass top* (Selected Models).
- the glass top* (Selected Models).

 The gas tube must be checked regularly for wear or leaks. It must be
- replaced every years. If it damaged or leaked then the gas tube should be replaced immediately.

 Keep the burners clean at all times to make sure gas consumption is
 - optimum. To clean the burner holes use a brush wire, If you clean the burners with water then make sure it should be dry properly after clean.

 Wipe the glass top and body with a dry cloth. If it is cleaned by soapy water
 - dry thoroughly with dry cloth. Do not use hard scrubbers, or any abrasive material as it may scratch the glass top and body Wash the pan support in water and dry it throughly before replace

Warranty

This warranty is valid for a period of two years from the date of original purchase, subject to the following terms and conditions.

- 1) The L.P. Gas Stove is only to be serviced by the Company or by its Authorised Agent.
- 2) The service/Repair will be provided at the company's Service/Authorized Service Center
- 3) The customer shall bear all the conveyance expense and other incidental expenses towards Service/Repair.
- 4) The customer shall carry the L.P. Gas Stove to the nearest Company service/Replacement under this Warranty at the earliest, but shall not be liable to do so within any specified time.
- 5) The warranty limited to the Repair/Replacement of parts of the L.P. Gas Stove
- 6) The warranty will continue and remain in force only for the unexpired period of the original Warranty, in regard to the Repair/Replacement of parts of the L.P. Gas Stove.

The L.P. Gas Stove shall be used strictly for domestic cooking/heating purpose in accordance with the instruction manual. The Company shall not be held liable for any accident, loss or damage (direct or indirect) to person or property cause by reason:

The warranty is not valid if:

a) Repairs/Service attended by unauthorized service person. b) Misuse/abuse or negligence on the part of the person, c) Defective leakage in the cylinder valves or tubing d) Misuse or negligence in the use of cooking utensils, e) Defects caused by improper/reckless use. f) Use of spurious spares/old, non-genuine spares. g) Cylinders,

valve, pressure regulator or tubing not conforming to the relevant specification. h) Failure to comply with any safety precaution or maintenance tip suggested by the Company, as well as the supplier of LPG/manufacturer of the pressure cooker or any other utensil or appliance used on the L.P. Gas Stove. i) Original serial number is deleted/defaced or altered.

- 8) The card is to be completed and signed by the dealer immediately on purchase.
 9) The company shall not be responsible for any special consequential
- damages or loss arising for any delay in the performance of this warranty due to cause beyond their control.

 10) Replacement of spares such as knobs, gas jets and gas cock
